| ✓ 1 C Monterey Jack shred | ✓ 1/4 C bl beans, rinsed |
| ✓ 6 oz strawberries sliced thin | ✓ 4 tsp fresh cilantro |

- Heat a lg skillet over med heat. Place tortilla in skillet with 1/4 C cheese over half and cook for 1 min until cheese melts.
- Arrange strawberries, avocado and beans over cheese, top with cilantro and fold.
- Cook for 1-2 minutes on each side or until golden brown.
